This correspondence is to submit an amendment to New Jersey's application for the State Fiscal Stabilization Fund available as a result of the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act (ARRA) of 2009. Today, via email, staff from your department advised that we should resubmit the attached page of our State Fiscal Stabilization Fund application to reflect a decision that has been made with regard to the use of the Government Services Fund.

The attachment is an amendment to page 11, in the section on "Uses of the Government Service Fund." We had previously indicated that the use of 82.5% of our Government Services Fund was "undetermined." We have now designated that the same 82.5% of the Government Services Fund will be used for Medicaid costs.

Thank you again for your commitment to preserving educational opportunities for the students across New Jersey and the rest of the country, and thank you for the continued assistance of your staff on this initiative.


