

Excel Spreadsheet for Table 3.6 of *The Empirical Curriculum*

This spreadsheet is provided for analysts who wish to verify the significance of differences in estimates of proportions of postsecondary students from the high school class of 1992 who earned any undergraduate credits in 109 course aggregates, by race/ethnicity.

The names of the aggregates (e.g. Marketing, Journalism, Health Services) are indicated in column Y. They do not follow the order of presentation in table 3.6. Rather, they follow the order of the field chapter headings in the *Taxonomy of Postsecondary Courses, 2003*.

This is a full-formula spreadsheet, with the formulas indicated in the formula bar for columns L through X.

Lines 111 and 112 indicate the comparison pairs by race/ethnicity:

White/African-American	Column N
White/Latino	Column P
White/Asian	Column R
African-American/Latino	Column T
African-American/Asian	Column V
Latino/Asian	Column X
