PREFACE

This document provides a description of the technical enhancements to the EDEN Submission System (ESS) version 5.3 released in March 2009 and subsequent software change requests (SCRs) implemented in the weeks and months following.

EDEN is a centralized, coordinated repository of state reported, K through 12, educational data residing at the U.S. Department of Education. The EDEN Submission System is an electronic system that facilitates the efficient and timely transmission of data from SEAs to the U.S. Department of Education.

1.0 PURPOSE

The purpose of this document is to educate the users of the EDEN Submission System about the improvements that have been made to the system and to provide guidance to users on issues that they may encounter with the new software release.

This document lists all system enhancements and documentation updates that were implemented with the ESS Release 5.3. The majority of the enhancements include support for ongoing enhancements and maintenance of the ESS.

Where applicable, items are prefixed with corresponding trouble ticket information. For example, "TT 233" refers to the trouble ticket opened by the software development team. "PSC 05-00367" refers to the ticket number opened by the Partner Support Center.

2.0 SUMMARY OF IMPROVEMENTS (RELEASE 5.3)

2.1 ESS Application Updates

ESS Release 5.3 (February 27, 2009) includes the following new system functionality:

- 1) TestTrack 3237 - Ticket 09-03362 – A state needed a school NCES ID Changed. In the fix, the school NCES ID was changed as requested.
- 2) TestTrack 3238 - Ticket 09-03349 – A state resubmitted their directory file to clear error S029-R21 (School did not report grades offered). All schools had grades offered reported, but the errors were still reported. In the fix, the edit was set to re-execute against the submitted data in order to clear the errors.
- 3) TestTrack 3240 - Ticket 09-03331 – A state submitted a school with an incorrect operational status and a previously used NCES ID. The state requested to have the operational status changed to “New” and the NCES ID cleared so a new one could be generated. In the fix, the operational status was changed to “New” and the NCES ID was cleared.
- 4) TestTrack 2994 - ESS 5.3 - Ticket 08-11910 – S052-R77 (warning) was added to the ESS business rules engine. The edit logic is as follows:

For any school that has a status of Open, New, Added, Changed Agency or Reopened, raise a warning if the grand total membership count for that school is NULL.

3.0 SUMMARY OF IMPROVEMENTS (RELEASE 5.3A)

3.1 ESS Application Updates

ESS Release 5.3A (March 6, 2009) includes the following new system functionality:

- 1) TestTrack 3260 - Ticket 09-03625 – The following submission types are no longer collected, but were still showing on the Submission Progress Report:

SEA: Districts Meeting AYP, Districts Not Meeting AYP, Schools Meeting AYP, Schools Not Meeting AYP
LEA: Schools Meeting AYP, Schools Not Meeting AYP

In the fix, the invalid submission types were removed from the Submission Progress Report.
- 2) TestTrack 3259 - Ticket 09-03747 – A state received multiple warnings on its 07-08 CCD Agency Report where the Current to Prior % Diff column was blank. In the fix, the stored procedure to display the current and prior year values for the edits was modified and the edits were reset for reevaluation.
- 3) TestTrack 3253 - Ticket 09-03332 – A state submitted an out of date NCES ID for a school when creating their SY 2007-08 school directory. In the fix, the

- operational status was changed to “New” and the NCES ID was cleared so a new one could be generated.
- 4) TestTrack 3254 - Ticket 09-03645 – A state inadvertently submitted schools to its SY 2006-07 directory when the schools were actually new for SY 2007-08. In the fix, the schools were deleted from the state’s SY 2006-07 directory.
 - 5) TestTrack 3263 - Ticket 09-03775 – A state inadvertently submitted two schools with “Closed” status in its SY 2008-09 school directory submission. In the fix, the schools were removed from the SY 2008-09 directory.
 - 6) TestTrack 3257 - Ticket 09-03734 – A state submitted incorrect dropout data at the LEA level for SY 2007-08. In the fix, the state’s LEA level N/X032 submission was deleted.
 - 7) TestTrack 3267 - Ticket 09-03934 – A state inadvertently submitted SY 2007-08 math proficiency data for education units that exist in the directory for funding purposes only. In the fix, the N/X109 data for the schools was deleted.
 - 8) TestTrack 3262 - Ticket 09-03329 – For SY 2007-08, when a state submitted Magnet Status = N/A, the information was forwarded to CCD as NULL, thereby triggering warnings indicating that Magnet Status was not submitted. In the fix, the information forwarded to CCD by ESS was modified to correctly indicate N/A when Magnet Status = N/A. The fix will apply to SY 2008-09 as well.
