### **Support Issues, Solutions, and Metrics**

The following is provided to give you some insight into issues being handled by your Partner Support Center (PSC):

#### **New Issues Affecting Multiple SEAs**

1. ESS: A state reported not having received automated emails for Validation Errors in several weeks. All other automated emails are received, just the ones generated by files that receive Validation Errors are not reaching them from ESS. Status: Issue was escalated to the development team and corrected in an update to ESS on 1/6/2011.
2. ESS: States that submitted their SY 2009-10 N/X040 files have generated Submission Errors in SY 2010-11. While all three levels of the file were submitted for SY 2009-10, the SEA level only is displaying errors for the SY 2010-11. Status: Issue was escalated to the development team and corrected in an update to ESS on 1/6/2011.
3. ERS: Multiple states reported that the timeliness indicators in their LEAD015 Reports for N078 school level are incorrect. Status: Escalated to the development team for resolution. All states are impacted and the SEA and LEA timeliness metrics are wrong as well. Should be resolved in an update to ERS this week.
