CSPR Part II Reopen Period Underway

Part II of the SY 2009-10 CSPR reopened for data corrections on Monday, April 11. If your state has submitted data in ESS since Part II closed on February 18, 2011, that should be included in recertification, a managing user needs to create a new version of the CSPR. After the nightly pre-fill refresh, the results of the ESS resubmissions will be populated in your state's CSPR.

So if data corrections are necessary for your state, please make sure you create a new version soon to allow time for the nightly refresh.

The Part II reopen period will close on Wednesday, April 27 at 5:00 PM EDT. Files to pre-fill the CSPR must be submitted by 5:00 PM EDT the previous day, April 26.

Support Issues, Solutions, and Metrics

The following is provided to give you some insight into issues being handled by your Partner Support Center (PSC):

New Issues Affecting Multiple SEAs

1. A state recently contacts PSC to ask if any changes were made regarding the 2010-11 collection for homeless files (N/X043 – Homeless Students Served and N/X118 – Homeless Students Enrolled). Status: For SY 2010-11, there were two approved changes to N/X043 and N/X118. The first change will be that the options for age and grades reported will include 'Under 3 Years' and 'Out of School.' States are not required to use these two permitted values for SY 2010-11. The second change is that the description of the time period reported will be clarify to emphasize that each state determines the reporting year.

In addition, at the the June EDFacts Coordinators' Meeting, we will be discussing ways to aggregate the data on homeless students by LEAs with subgrants and without subgrants.

2. A state recently contacted PSC to clarify the reporting period of SY 2010-11 file N/X160, High School Graduates Postsecondary Enrollment. The file spec table 1.2-1 currently indicates "For SY 2010-11, report on what happened to the cohort of students who graduated in SY 2008-09 between graduation and the end of SY 2010-11." The table indicates that a student should be included for two full years but the guidance then refers to 16 months in section 2.0. Status: This ticket has been escalated and the file spec table 1.2-1 will be changed to reflect the 16 month date range in section 2.0 of file spec N/X160.

3. At least two states have reported that the pre-fill data has disappeared from Part II of the current version of their SY 2009-10 CSPR. Status: This issue was escalated to the SI team who identified a trend which impacts the pre-fill data for 15 states. SI has re-run the pre-fills for the states involved, resolving the issue. If your state is experiencing this issue, please contact PSC.
