Support Issues, Solutions, and Metrics

The following is provided to give you some insight into issues being handled by your Partner Support Center (PSC):

New Issues Affecting Multiple SEAs

1. ERS - Data in the State Submission Status Timeliness and Completeness Report (LEAD018) have not been updated since the evening of Thursday, April 28th. As a result, the overall timeliness gauge is inaccurate for the files that were due on Saturday, April 30 (N/X002 - Children with Disabilities (IDEA) - School Age and N/X046 - LEP Students in LEP Program). The timeliness gauge is showing a lower percentage than it should be.

Status: The EDFacts Reporting System team has resolved this issue which should be implemented by 5/7/11.

2. ESS - State contacted PSC inquiring if Dispute Resolution, Table 7 data for IDEA will be reported through EDFacts.

Status: ED will collect the data for Table 7 - Dispute Resolution through EMAPS with reporting only at the SEA level. No additional file spec will be developed and the EMAPS process will mirror Table 7. The Dispute Resolution data will be due on the first Wednesday in November.
