**ESS 7.1 Now Available**

Version 7.1 of the EDEN Submission System (ESS) is now released and available for use by states. The primary purpose of this 7.1 release is to enhance the EDEN Submission System (ESS) to allow for the collection of the majority of the SY 2010-11 file specification data that are due on or before December 15, 2011 and to implement data collection functionality and data quality updates related to this data.

**UPDATE! Additional Details for the SY 2010-11 CTE and SFSF Data Submissions**

As mentioned in last week's Support Update the following file specifications will not be collected through ED Facts for SY 2010-11:

- N/X158 CTE Placement (planned deadline 12/31/11)
- N/X161 HS Graduates Postsecondary Credits Earned (planned deadline 2/10/12)
- N/X168 Charter Schools (planned deadline 2/10/12)

Additionally ED has provided the following information about these data submissions:

N/X161 HS Graduates Postsecondary Credits Earned and N/X168 Charter Schools - ED Facts will not be collecting the HS Graduates Postsecondary Credits Earned (used for metric C12) or additional data on charter schools (used for metrics d11 and d12) from the states for SY 2010-11. States are still required to make data publically available in accordance with the schedules in their phase II applications.

N/X158 CTE Placement – The Perkins Consolidated Annual Report (CAR) is due December 31, 2011. The CAR will collect all the data for postsecondary and adult education. The CAR will also collect some data on secondary education including the placement indicator (5S1). The following secondary indicators will be collected through EDFacts:

***Reminder: SY 2009-10 SNF One-Year Later File Submissions Due by September 2, 2011***

The Common Core of Data (CCD) at NCES is planning to update the 2009-10 state level Membership and Staff FTE data for the CCD State Non-Fiscal (SNF) One-Year Later File in Fall, 2011. The one-year-later data will become permanent and official statistics for state-level Membership and Staff FTE counts. In order for NCES to obtain and process the accurate data, please review your 2009-10 state level Membership and Staff FTE data in ED*Facts* and make any necessary corrections by September 2, 2011. If your current data are accurate, no action needs to be taken. Any data submitted after September 2, 2011 will NOT be used by NCES for producing official 2009-10 state level statistics.

In accordance with new communications protocols, when you submit to correct these data, please notify PSC and provide a brief explanation of what you are correcting and the reason. In this case, the reason would be to finalize SNF One-Year Later data. PSC will then notify NCES and Census.

#### **New Issues Affecting Multiple SEAs**

1. ESS – States have contacted PSC reporting receiving Submission Error S046-R10, *“The total number of students reported as enrolled in an LEP Program (N/X046) is greater than the total number of LEP students enrolled in public education (N/X141).”* Status: No state has yet submitted N/X141 – LEP Enrolled, PSC believes this error is misfiring for multiple states. This ticket has been escalated to our technical team for a resolution.

There are no new or updated knowledgebase articles this week.
