### **NEW! CSPR Pre-fill Reports Launching**

The following CSPR Pre-fill Reports should be available in ERS on Tuesday, 10/04/2011 for the SY2010-11 CSPR collection:

- Public School Choice and Supplemental Educational Services - CSPR 1.4.9 (EDEN004)
- Persistently Dangerous Schools - CSPR 1.7 (EDEN007)
- Migrant Child Counts - CSPR 1.10 (EDEN010)
- Section 1003(a) and 1003(g) Allocations to LEAs and Schools - CSPR 1.4.8.5.2 (EDEN012)

These reports show ED Facts Submission System (ESS) Data that will be used to populate your state's SY 2010-11 CSPR and help your state's program office and federal liaisons with these data submissions. You will be able to run the reports and present your CSPR team with data formatted as the data will appear in the CSPR collection tool. These reports can be found by in the "ED Facts Reports for CSPR folder" under the ED Facts Data Collection.

The remainder of the Part I Pre-fill Reports will be released in the coming weeks. In addition, the report entitled "ESS Submission Status Report for CSPR SY 2009-10 - Part I (CSPR016a)" will be retired. We will be updating LEAD018 to include a prompt selection that will filter LEAD018 by the files required for CSPR Part I and Part II. The final release data for the updated LEAD018 has not yet been determined. PSC will notify states when it is launched.

### **Reminder: New Version of N/X162 – Internet Access Posted**

A revised 162 file specification for SY 2010-11 has been posted on [www.ed.gov/edfacts](http://www.ed.gov/edfacts). Please note that reporting 'Other Devices' is **optional**. For SY 2011-12, the program office plans to eliminate 'Other Devices' as a permitted value for DG744 in File 162.

The following is provided to give you some insight into issues being handled by your Partner Support Center (PSC):

New Issues Affecting Multiple SEAs:

1. ESS – A state contacted PSC to ask how to report students who are under 3 years of age (permitted value 'under 3' and out of school (permitted value 'out of school') in the N/X118 – Homeless Students Enrolled file specification. Status: ED has determined that these two permitted values will be removed from the spec for SY 2010-11 and forward. This change should be reflected in the documentation soon.
