***NEW! Part I of the SY 2010-11 CSPR Opens Monday, November 7, 2011***

Part I of the SY 2010-11 Consolidated State Performance Report opens this coming Monday, November 7, 2011. Once the system has been launched and verified on Monday morning, PSC will send a broadcast announcing that the system is open.

Part I will close at 5:00 p.m., EST on Friday, December 16, 2011. All files for pre-fill must be successfully submitted to ESS by 5:00 p.m., EST on the previous day, Thursday, December 15, 2011.

***NEW! File Processing to Stop Over the Weekend***

In order to facilitate the removal of SY 2007-08 data from ESS, file processing will be temporarily halted over the weekend. Processing is scheduled to stop at 12:30 p.m., EDT on Saturday, November 5 and will resume no later than 9:00 p.m., EST on Sunday, November 6.

During this time, all ESS functionality will be available, including file submission by users, but files will not process until the job is re-started.

We will be updating LEAD018 to include a prompt selection that will filter LEAD018 by the files required for CSPR Part I and Part II. The final release date for the updated LEAD018 has not yet been determined. PSC will notify states when it is launched.
