NEW! Updated LEAD018 with CSPR Filter Will Be Available Tomorrow at Noon

The reports team has updated the State Submission Status Timeliness and Completeness Report (LEAD018) to include a filter for CSPR Part I and CSPR Part II files. This filter enables you to track your file submission progress for CSPR files. On the LEAD018 prompt page, you are now required to select a file group. Selecting All Files as the file group will return the same results as running LEAD018 prior to this change. If you select the CSPR Part I Files group, then cells for file/level combinations not required for CSPR Part 1 will have a grey background. The timeliness and completeness gauge for the CSPR Part I Files group will only count CSPR Part 1 files. Having 100% complete for CSPR Part I File group means that you have completed submitting all of your CSPR Part I files. Currently N132, which is not pre-filled into CSPR but is used in CSPR Part I, will have a grey background as a CSPR Part 1 File group. We plan to make N132 part of the CSPR Part 1 file group in the future. LEAD018 can be found in the Submission Status Reports folder.

Note: CSPR016a and CSPR016b are retired and will no longer be available for use.

The SY 2010-11 Consolidated State Performance Report is now open in ESS. SEA staff with active user accounts can now login and provide data manually, and all of the files required to pre-fill your state's CSPR are currently enabled in ESS. The certification deadline for CSPR is 5:00 p.m., EST on Friday, December 16, 2011. All files to pre-fill CSPR must be submitted by 5:00 p.m., EST the previous day, Thursday, December 15, 2011. [System Status](#) section below, large files (especially SCH level) slow the average file processing time considerably. Please take that into account and submit your files as soon as you are able.

Support Issues, Solutions, and Metrics

The following is provided to give you some insight into issues being handled by your Partner Support Center (PSC):

New Issues Affecting Multiple SEAs

1. ESS – A state contacted PSC reporting receiving an error in all grade levels containing data in CSPR Section 1.3 for math, reading/language arts, and science. The error that they are receiving is: “The number of all students tested is greater than 105% or less than 95% of the sum of male and female students tested. Explain.” Status: PSC has investigated this report and believes the error is misfiring for multiple states. PSC has escalated the issue to our technical team for further research.
2. ESS – Multiple states have contacted PSC due to receiving a format error in their .csv N106 files. Status: PSC has escalated this issue and our technical team has confirmed that this was a system issue. If your state received a format error before Wednesday 11/16, please resubmit the file to ESS.
