NEW! ED Facts Calendar and Due Dates List

As of January 2012, the ED Facts calendar no longer lists the files due each month. The complete file due dates list for SY 2011-12 can be found on the ED Facts web page, www.ed.gov/edfacts, under ED Facts System Documentation. This list was updated last week to reflect the deletion of files 071, 117, 162. These files, which collect data related to education technology, will not be collected as of SY 2011-12.

Reminder: EMAPS CCD- Grades Offered and Graduates Survey Due January 27

The CCD-Grades Offered and Graduates Survey is now open in EMAPS. ED has identified the CCD Non-Fiscal Coordinator as the person to respond to this survey. All CCD Non-Fiscal Coordinators who do not already have EMAPS accounts should have received an individual e-mail from EMAPS containing the username/password information needed to access the EMAPS website. The subject line of the e-mail will read “EMAPS: ED Facts Metadata and Process System Password Change.” If you have not received this e-mail or need technical assistance, please contact PSC for assistance.

This collection will be open from now through January 27, 2012.

The report titles are:

- Improving Basic Programs Operated By Local Educational Agencies (Title I, Part A) - CSPR 2.1 (EDEN013)
- Education of Migrant Children (Title I, Part C) - CSPR 2.3.1.1 only (EDEN014a)
- Education of Migrant Children (Title I, Part C) - CSPR 2.3 (EDEN014b)
- Prevention And Intervention Programs For Children And Youth Who Are Neglected, Delinquent, or At Risk (Title I, Part D, Subparts 1 And 2) - CSPR 2.4 (EDEN015)

These reports show ED Facts Submission System (ESS) Data that will be used to populate your state's SY 2010-11 CSPR Part II and help your state's program office and federal liaisons with these data submissions. You will be able to run the reports and present your CSPR team with data formatted as the data will appear in the CSPR collection tool. These reports can be found in the ED Facts Reporting System (ERS) in the "ED Facts Reports for CSPR folder" under the ED Facts Data Collection.

Reminder: SY 2010-11 Graduation Rate Data

Graduation rate data for SY 2010-11 are due into ED Facts by January 31, 2012. States are required to report the regulatory cohort graduation rate using files N/X150 and N/X151 *unless* the state has received an official extension from the Office of Elementary and Secondary Education for reporting the regulatory rate. The few states who have received an extension may continue to report their graduation rate using file N/X041, and those states should contact PSC for a copy of the N/X041 file specification. States who are approved to report extended-year cohort graduation rates for SY 2010-11 may use files N/X150 and N/X151 to report both a four-year cohort rate and a five-year cohort rate. States who are approved to report a six-year cohort rate for SY 2010-11 should contact PSC for specific instructions on how to report six-year rates for SY 2010-11.
