NEW! File N/X030 Discipline Incidents Reporting Requirements

If your SEA used funds from either the Office of Safe and Drug-Free Schools (OSDFS) State Grants program OR the School Improvement Grants (SIG) program during SY 2010-11, file N/X030 Discipline Incidents must be reported by February 28, 2012.

NEW! Submission of SY 2009-10 SIG Baseline Data into ESS

The ED Facts Submission System was recently enabled to accept the SY 2009-10 School Improvement Grant (SIG) files that were manually submitted by states last year. These files include: 139 (SCH), 159, 160, 163 (SCH), 166 and 167. In order to maximize ED's use of this data, PSC will be submitting those files into ESS beginning February 27. The SIG program office plans to begin analyzing the SY 2009-10 data against the SY 2010-11 data once the baseline data are available in the system. Please let PSC know as soon as possible if you expect to be updating and resubmitting your SIG SY 2009-10 data prior to April 30, in which case, PSC will not submit the original baseline files into ESS.

NEW! ED Facts Reporting System Updates

Reminder: CSPR Part I Program Office Review and OMB MAX Invitation

The U.S. Department of Education's Office of Elementary and Secondary Education (OESE) staff have completed their review process for Part I of the SY 2010-11 CSPR data. Those comments are available for your state to begin review and identify data that need to be resubmitted. This year, OESE has added a new feature via the platform of OMB MAX (OMBMax.gov), which allows ED to post each state's spreadsheet on a secure page that only your state can see. States have the option to respond to comments within the spreadsheet if they can explain the issue identified either through the emailed version or directly to the OMB

MAX site; however, it's not required. Your state's ED*Facts* and CSPR coordinators should have received an email from the OMB MAX system inviting you to join the OMB Max community. Note: Part I will reopen on February 27, 2012 and close on March 9, 2012.

Part II of the SY 2010-11 Consolidated State Performance Report opened Monday, January 9, 2012 and will close at 5:00 p.m., EST on Friday, February 17, 2012. All files for pre-fill must be successfully submitted to ESS by 5:00 p.m., EST on the previous day, Thursday, February 16, 2012.
