**Final Reminder: Part II of the SY 2010-11 CSPR Closes Tomorrow**

Part II of the SY 2010-11 Consolidated State Performance Report opened for data corrections on Monday, March 26, 2012

New versions of Part II must be certified by 5:00 p.m., EDT, **TOMORROW**, Friday, April 6, 2012. All files for pre-fill must be successfully submitted to ESS by 5:00 p.m., EDT, **TODAY**, Thursday, April 5, 2012.

**Reminder: CSPR Part II Program Office Review and OMB MAX Invitation**

The U.S. Department of Education's Office of Elementary and Secondary Education (OESE) staff have completed their review process for Part II of the SY 2010-11 CSPR data. Those comments were made available last week for your state to begin review and identify data that need to be resubmitted. For both parts of the CSPR this year, OESE has added a new feature via the platform of OMB MAX (OMBMax.gov), which allows ED to post each state's spreadsheet on a secure page that only your state can see. States have the option to respond to comments within the spreadsheet if they can explain the issue identified either through the emailed version or directly to the OMB MAX site; however, it's not required. During the Part I data verification process, your state's ED Facts and CSPR coordinators should have received an email from the OMB MAX system inviting you to join the OMB Max community. **Reminder: Public Comment Period for CSPR and ED Facts is Currently Open**

The proposed Consolidated State Performance Report (CSPR) for SY 2011-12 and preliminary CSPR for SY 2012-13 are now available for review and public comment. The preliminary SY 2012-13 CSPR includes changes that would impact the ED Facts SY 2012-13 collection. Copies of the proposed information collection request may be accessed from <http://edicsweb.ed.gov> by selecting the "Browse Pending Collections" link and clicking on link number 04804. When you access the information collection, click on "Download Attachments" to view. The attachment entitled "[CSPR SY 2012-13 Populating with ED Facts Final.doc](#)" specifies the proposed changes for the CSPR for which data would be collected through ED Facts. The public comment period closes on April 16, 2012.

**Reminder: Submission of SY 2009-10 SIG Baseline Data into ESS**

The ED Facts Submission System was recently enabled to accept most of the SY 2009-10 School Improvement Grant (SIG) files that were manually submitted by states last year. These files include: 159, 160, 166 and 167. The SIG program office plans to begin analyzing the SY 2009-10 data against the SY 2010-11 data once the baseline data are available in the system.

PSC has begun submitting these files on behalf of states. After checking to see if the state has already submitted an updated version of these files for SY 2009-10, analysts will submit the

exact file that was e-mailed to PSC around this time last year. If there are format errors, PSC will correct these and resubmit. If there are validation errors, the analyst will send the file back to the ED Facts Coordinator to be corrected. This is because it may require a change to the data, and PSC is not authorized to alter state data.

Please let PSC know as soon as possible if you expect to be updating and resubmitting any of these SIG SY 2009-10 data prior to April 30, in which case, PSC will not submit the original baseline files into ESS. If you need to update the SY 2009-10 baseline school-level data for files 139 or 163, please send those files to PSC.
