***NEW! EDFacts Coordinators' Access to EDGB MAX***

As was discussed last week during the *EDFacts* Coordinators' meeting in Washington, DC, ED will establish access to the EDGB MAX site for all state *EDFacts* Coordinators. This will be the same account you may have had established to view your data findings for CSPR, just with different permissions. ***NEW! File C161 Will Not Be Collected in SY 2011-12***

ED has decided that file C161 - HS Graduates Postsecondary Credit Earned Table will not be collected in SY 2011-12. It has been removed from the File Due Dates spreadsheet on ED.gov and will be removed from the State Submission Plan and the LEAD Reports at the next possible opportunity. The file will be collected in SY 2012-13

***NEW! EDFacts Coordinators' Conference Materials***

***NEW! EMAPS Outage Monday Morning***

On Sunday, EDUCATE will be applying security patches that will require a restart of our *EMAPS* server. The restart will be done as soon and as quickly as possible Monday morning. Until the restart is complete, users may not be able to access *EMAPS*.

### **Reminder: Submission of SY 2009-10 SIG Baseline Data into ESS**

The ED Facts Submission System was recently enabled to accept most of the SY 2009-10 School Improvement Grant (SIG) files that were manually submitted by states last year. These files include: 159, 160, 166 and 167. The SIG program office plans to begin analyzing the SY 2009-10 data against the SY 2010-11 data once the baseline data are available in the system.

PSC has begun submitting these files on behalf of states. After checking to see if the state has already submitted an updated version of these files for SY 2009-10, analysts will submit the exact file that was e-mailed to PSC around this time last year. If there are format errors, PSC will correct these and resubmit. If there are validation errors, the analyst will send the file back to the ED Facts Coordinator to be corrected. This is because it may require a change to the data, and PSC is not authorized to alter state data.

Please let PSC know as soon as possible if you expect to be updating and resubmitting any of these SIG SY 2009-10 data prior to April 30, in which case, PSC will not submit the original baseline files into ESS. If you need to update the SY 2009-10 baseline school-level data for files 139 or 163, please send those files to PSC.
