These data are submitted to meet the annual data reporting requirements under IDEA Section 618. The data will be evaluated for timeliness, completeness, and accuracy to support the SPP/APR Indicators C14 and B20.

Reminder: LEAD019 Report Is Now Available

The new LEAD019 Report has been launched and is available for states to view. This report provides the U.S. Department of Education (ED) and state education agencies (SEAs) with information on the ED Facts submission progress at a national level. The report aggregates each state's current number of SEA, LEA, and school files submitted and marked as complete against the total number of files expected to be submitted over the school year as stated in the State's Submission Plan in EMAPS (in order to measure completeness). It also displays the cumulative timeliness of the state's file submissions as they come due. The report provides both a high-level status overview of the submission progress by SEA, LEA, and school level, as well as a detailed view of actual submissions aggregated across states for each active file specification.

Note: The status of submission of each individual state can be seen in LEAD018. This report only provides a national view.
