NEW! Suspension of File Processing at 8:01 p.m on Thursday, February 14 For CSPR Data Verification

Following the 5:00 p.m., EST Thursday, February 14, 2013 deadline to submit files for Part II of the SY 2011-12 CSPR, file processing will be halted to accommodate Data Quality Assurance (DQA) activities for CSPR. To accommodate the DQA activities, file processing will stop at 8:01 p.m. on Thursday, February 14, 2013 and resume the following day. During this time, files can be uploaded to ESS as usual, but file processing to the database will be suspended. Submitted files will appear “stuck” in ‘Received’ status. These files will not actually be stuck, but rather waiting for the database to be restarted so that they can be processed.

Error processing will be functioning normally, so errors in files will be identified prior to them being moved to the database for staging. Please continue to monitor your submissions for errors, but no files will receive ‘Transmittal OK’ until processing is resumed. If your state submits a file and it does not receive errors. It is likely ready to be staged into the database and will be, in the order it was received, once file processing resumes.

Barring complications, file processing is scheduled to resume the following morning at 11:00 a.m., EST. PSC will notify states when processing has resumed. We apologize for any inconvenience.

Reminder: OESE Has Finished Its Review of SY2011-12 CSPR Part I Data

The Office of Elementary and Secondary Education (OESE) has finished its initial review of the SY 2011-12 CSPR Part I data. States should have received their comments on Monday, February 4th. Just like last year, comments were sent to EDFacts and CSPR coordinators by PSC, and are also available through each state’s OMB MAX space. States will have the option to respond back to OESE’s comments, as necessary, either directly to PSC or through the OMB MAX space. If you want access to the OMB MAX space and do not believe you have it, please contact us immediately. We look forward to working with you on the next stage of the data review process.

Reminder: IDEA Part B Child Count Certification Form

To meet the Child Count data collection requirements, please have the authorized official of the agency complete **and sign** the form as a certification that the Child Count data submitted by your State is an accurate and unduplicated count of children with disabilities receiving special education and related services on the State designed child count date. The completed and signed form should be submitted electronically via email to the Partner Support Center (PSC) at EDEN_SS@ed.gov or by fax to PSC at the number below. The document was due yesterday, February 6, 2013 (the same day the Child Count files were due).
