NEW! SY 2012-13 CSPR Part I - UPDATE

Due to the Federal Government shutdown, the SY 2012-13 Consolidated State Performance Report (CSPR) did not open as scheduled on October 10th, 2013. Now that the shutdown has been resolved, ED has put rescheduling CSPR activities at the top of its priority list. As soon as open date and the date for the Technical webinar are determined, PSC will send out a dedicated broadcast. The policy webinars have been rescheduled. The dates and registration links can be found below. At this time, states should continue with data submissions for CSPR Part I. The close date remains December 20, and all ED Facts files that populate Part I of the CSPR must be submitted by 8 p.m., EST on December 19th, 2013.

Reminder: Transition from EDFacts Data Viewer to the EMDR

The EDFacts team is transitioning from the Data Viewer to the EDFacts Metadata Repository (EMDR) which includes a data dictionary for EDFacts data. The Data Viewer, currently accessed via a link on ERS or ED.gov, will be retired within the next week or so. After that date, if you try to access the Data Viewer via ED.gov or ERS, in place of the Data Viewer link, you will find EMDR data dictionary spreadsheets with the same content as the Data Viewer. Users will be able to access a training slide deck under the Training portion of ERS.

Reminder: EMAPS IDEA Part C Exiting and Dispute Resolution and Part B Dispute Resolution Processes Due November 6, 2013

The IDEA Part C Exiting and Dispute Resolution and the Part B Dispute Resolution Processes opened on 10/2/13. Data for all three processes are due on 11/6/2013 11:59 PM EST. These data must be submitted via the EDFacts Metadata and Process System (EMAPS; <https://emaps.ed.gov/suite/apps>).

These data are submitted to meet the annual data reporting requirements under IDEA Section 618. The data will be evaluated for timeliness, completeness, and accuracy.

Reminder: Public Comment Period for NEW SY 2013-14 HQT Data Collection is Open

To meet a Continuing Resolution request, the Department is proposing a NEW SY 2013-14 data collection about Highly Qualified Teachers who are in alternative route to certification programs. The collection includes State and LEA counts (in FTE) for three groups: all highly qualified teachers, all highly qualified special education teachers, and all highly qualified Title III language instruction teachers. The proposed collection is now available for review and public comment. The additions would impact the ED*Facts* SY 2013-14 collection (with a proposed due date of 06/01/2014). Reminder: Missing Scale Score Metadata Review (FS 159)

PSC sent outreach to states requesting a review of missing data identified in their SY2010-11 and SY2011-12 scale score data (C159). In addition, states were asked to fill out a table with metadata on their SY2011-12 scale scores as well as inform ED if

they reported any combined scale scores where students could take multiple assessments in math or reading/language arts within the same grade. The due date for this request was August 14th, 2013.
