Reminder: CSPR Edit Checks 1013 and 1021 in Section 1.2 Are Firing Incorrectly

The following CPSR Edit checks are currently firing incorrectly and should be ignored until the defect is corrected. ED anticipates that the defects will be fixed by November 22, at which point users will be notified through the PSC Support Update.

- CSPR-1013 (Question 1.2.4): The percentage of students with disabilities (IDEA) participating in the regular assessment (with or without accommodations) is less than 80%. Check data carefully.
- CSPR-1021 (Question 1.2.6): The percentage of students with disabilities (IDEA) participating in the regular assessment (with or without accommodations) is less than 80%. Check data carefully.

Reminder: UPDATED CLOSING DATE! Public Comment Period for NEW SY 2013-14 HQT Data Collection is Open

Due to the federal government shutdown and technical issues with the www.regulations.gov website, the public comment period will now close on November 18, 2013. Official notification of the change will be published next week.

To meet a Continuing Resolution request, the Department is proposing a NEW SY 2013-14 data collection about Highly Qualified Teachers who are in alternative route to certification programs. The collection includes State and LEA counts (in FTE) for three

groups: all highly qualified teachers, all highly qualified special education teachers, and all highly qualified Title III language instruction teachers. The proposed collection is now available for review and public comment. The additions would impact the ED*Facts* SY 2013-14 collection (with a proposed due date of 06/01/2014).
