NEW! SY 2012-13 CSPR Part II Will Re-Open for Corrections March 24, 2014

Part II of the CSPR will re-open on Monday, March 24 for corrections. To submit revised data, open a new version of CSPR Part II, make any necessary revisions, and recertify by 5:00PM EDT on Friday, April 4. Any ED Facts files must be resubmitted by 8:00PM EDT on Thursday, April 3 in order to be populated into the CSPR.

NEW! 30 Day Public Comment Period for NEW SY 2013-14 HQT Data Collection is Open

To meet a Continuing Resolution requirement, the Department proposed a NEW SY 2013-14 data collection about Highly Qualified Teachers who are in alternate route to certification programs (notice published September 12, 2013). We received public comments, responded to the comments, and made minor modifications to the collection. The proposed due date is June 30, 2014 and the collection includes State and LEA counts (in FTE) for three groups: all highly qualified teachers, all highly qualified special

education teachers, and all highly qualified Title III language instruction teachers. The proposed collection is now available for review and public comment. NEW! School Attendance Boundary Survey

ED received a question about the School Attendance Boundary Survey. The voluntary survey is being conducted by the National Center for Education Statistics (NCES) and was distributed to school district superintendents. NCES is collecting school boundary information from a national sample of districts. Reminder: Outreach to States about SY2012-13 CSPR Part II Data

States have begun receiving feedback regarding potential data quality issues for CSPR Part II data. PSC sent emails containing several attachments. States have until 8:00 PM EDT on **April 3rd** to review the feedback and resubmit files to fix any known issues. In order for resubmitted data to appear in the CSPR, states must open a new version of CSPR Part II and certify it by 5:00 PM EDT on April 4th. Please contact PSC with any questions.

Reminder: Monthly Calendar/Due Date Update Broadcast from PSC

PSC will begin sending a monthly broadcast to ED*Facts* Coordinators detailing any changes to the ED*Facts* Calendar Word doc and the current SY's File Due Dates Excel spreadsheet. Last week's March broadcast will serve as a baseline that states should be using for planning file submissions and data responses.
