NEW! OSEP Feedback on IDEA Part B Child Count and Educational Environments Data (FS002 and 089) Posted; Final Updates Needed by July 2, 2014

OSEP posted the Data Quality Reports and Year-to-Year Comparison Reports about the SY 2013-14 Part B Child Count and Educational Environments data on the OSEP Data Quality Review and Collaboration page on OMB MAX: <https://max.omb.gov/community/x/FxPdJQ>. Final data must be in ESS by **11:59pm on July 2, 2014**.

SY 2013-14 IDEA Part B Child Count and Educational Environments files (due April 2014): July 2, 2014 is the new freeze date for all IDEA data submitted April 2014.

SY 2013-14 IDEA Part B Child Count and Educational Environments Data in the ESS as of July 2nd will be used for data products such as the Annual Report to Congress and data files posted publicly.

Please address the comments on the uploaded Data Quality Reports in your data resubmissions. States can only access the IDEA Data Quality Reports from OMB MAX. IDEA Data Managers, please work with your ED Facts Coordinators to review comments and resubmit IDEA data, as needed, to ESS.

The Year-to-Year Comparison Reports for the SY 2013-14 Part B Child Count and Educational Environments data provide states and entities with an analysis of changes in the counts reported for the most recent year's data collection (SY 2013-2014) and the previous year's data collection (SY 2012-13).

Any large year-to-year change in the count or percentages are highlighted in red in the Reports. Only states or entities that had one or more large year-to-year changes (i.e., above the 20/20 threshold) received a Year-to-Year Comparison Report on OMB Max. OSEP is requesting that states and entities review any large year-to-year changes and provide explanations for the increases/ decreases in counts on OMB Max. **Please have**
