NEW! OSEP Feedback on FFY 2012/ SY 2012-13 IDEA Part B MOE Reduction & CEIS Posted; Final Updates Needed by August 29th

OSEP has posted the FFY 2012/ SY 2012-13 IDEA Part B Maintenance of Effort (MOE) Reduction & Coordinated Early Intervening Services (CEIS) Data Quality Report on OMB MAX (<https://max.omb.gov/community/x/FxPdJQ>). Final data must be in EMAPS by **11:59pm Eastern on August 29th, 2014.**

EMAPS (<https://emaps.ed.gov/suite/apps>) will open on August 4, 2014 for states to resubmit these data. Please note that the EMAPS system will send automated emails to all states when the system opens for resubmissions.

OSEP staff from the Research to Practice (RTP) Division and the Monitoring and State Improvement Planning (MSIP) Division coordinated their review the MOE Reduction & CEIS data submitted in May 2014. Therefore the feedback in the Data Quality Reports reflects comments from RTP and MSIP.

August 29th is the new freeze date for the FFY 2012/ SY 2012-13 IDEA Part B MOE Reduction & CEIS data submitted May 2014.

The FFY 2012/ SY 2012-13 IDEA Part B MOE Reduction & CEIS data in the EMAPS as of August 29th will be used for data products such as the Annual Report to Congress and data files posted publicly.

Please address the comments on the uploaded Data Quality Reports in your data resubmissions or data notes. States can only access the IDEA Data Quality Reports from OMB MAX. **Please have data notes and revised data submissions entered into the appropriate system by 11:59pm Eastern on August 29, 2014.**

Reminder: EMAPS Assessment Metadata Survey Webinar

The purpose of this webinar was to convey what states need to know about the new EMAPS Assessment Metadata Survey. The EMAPS Assessment Metadata Survey collects and stores assessment metadata for files C175, C178, C179, C004, as well as C171 (Flexibility Subgroups). This information is necessary to pre-populate key parts of section 1.3 of the Consolidated State Performance Report (CSPR) and to calculate the percentage of students considered proficient for the public assessment files.
