New! Outreach on Discrepancies Identified between SY2012-13 Assessment Data and NCES Poll Results

The Policy and Program Studies Service recently conducted an analysis comparing proficiency rate changes between states' SY2011-12 and SY2012-13 math and reading/language arts assessment data to state responses on the NCES Poll on Changes to State Assessments administered in 2013. PSC will be reaching out on Monday, August 11th to states where discrepancies were identified requesting clarification regarding state assessment changes. The outreach will be sent to state NAEP Coordinators, Assessment Directors, and ED Facts Coordinators. Responses to the outreach will be due Friday, August 22nd.

New! IDEA MOE/CEIS EMAPS Resubmission Period

The IDEA Maintenance of Effort / Coordinated Early Intervening Services (MOE/CEIS) EMAPS collection reopened Monday, August 4 for states that need to update the SY 2012-13 CEIS/MOE data. State IDEA Data Managers are the survey respondents. The resubmission period ends August 29, 2014.

New! Thank you! LEA Input During and After Conference Working Session

During the ED Facts Coordinators meeting, ED requested input from states about the data reported for C191 about students sent/received. Eight states provided input in writing that ED is using with its ED Facts Data Governance Board (EDGB) workgroup to inform future plans for C191. The EDGB workgroup says, "thank you!" and found the input immensely helpful. The workgroup will discuss recommendations next week with

EDGB and the full board will vote on those recommendations in September. More information will be provided as soon as possible.
