Title: CTE Files not yet available in the SY2009-10 EMAPS State Submission Plan

Issue Description:

With the release of ESS 6.3, the seven SY2009-10 CTE files can be submitted to ED $Facts$ . However the SY2009-10 State Submission Plan in EMAPS (Version 2) does not yet accommodate four of these files, namely:

- 154 - CTE Concentrators Graduation Rate
- 155 - CTE Participants in Programs for Non-traditional
- 156 - CTE Concentrators in Programs for Non-traditional
- 157 - CTE Concentrators Technical Skills

Also, CTE Files N/X148 and N/X149 display on the EMAPS SSP file listings page even though they are no longer used.

Solution:

The EMAPS SSP will be updated (Version 3) to correct these issues, currently scheduled for release on 11/1/2010. N/X148 and N/X149 will be replaced by N/X155 and N/X156. Files N/X154 and N/X157 will be added to the EMAPS SSP as well. States will be notified by the PSC when EMAPS SSP Version 3 is actually released for use.

Note that these CTE files are not due until December 31, 2010, which will provide ample time for states to complete their EMAPS SSP with planned submission dates (or “exemption” in the comments field if the data will be submitted to the CAR system instead of ED $Facts$ ) so that Timeliness will be reflected accurately.
