Title: How to Find GEPA Award Amounts by State and FFY

Issue Description:

This article explains how to find Federal Fiscal Year (FFY) award amounts (including GEPA funding) by accessing the ED Grant Award online database. This information is helpful in knowing the allocated amount states received or should expect from ED for each of the programs.

The Grant Award Database contains information on grant and cooperative-agreement awards for most recent fiscal years.

To obtain a summary of the Federal Fiscal Year grant award amount information by state and Federal Fiscal Year:

1. Access the following link:

2. Once the webpage loads, select Grant Awards, then Database for Awards, then Summary Reports, then Grant Award Totals by CFDA Subprogram.
3. Select the Fiscal Year, State, and Report Type (HTML or PDF), then select the Run Report button.

The report will appear in a separate window for viewing or printing.
