Title: Reporting an ARRA funded school as a TAS or SWP

Issue Description:

States have asked if a school with a Targeted Assistance program (TAS) is broadened to be a Schoolwide Program (SWP) incorporating ARRA funds, is the school reported as TAS or SWP?

If a school that was a TAS becomes a SWP, the State should report the school as a SWP.

Also, under section 1114 of ESEA, the percentage of low-income students in a Title I school must be at least 40 percent for the school to be a SWP. The source of a school's Title I funding (i.e., Title I, Part A funds provided through the regular appropriation and/or Title I, Part A provided through the ARRA) does not affect whether the school is eligible to operate a SWP.
