Title: Reporting membership for students tuitioned out of a public education entity

Issue Description:

This article describes the procedures for reporting membership for students who are tuitioned to a school that is not run by a public education entity in their state.

Solution:

All students should be reported at the LEA that is fiscally responsible for that student. This is true, even if the LEA sends the student to an out of district school, a private school, or out of state school.

Since the state is ultimately responsible for the LEA, all the students who are reported at the LEA level need to be reported at the state level. The State count can be higher than the LEA count if they cannot place the students in an LEA.
