Title: Questions Regarding Geocoding

Issue Description:

This article responds to any state concerns or questions regarding Geocoding.

Every year the Census Bureau asks SEAs to update their school district boundaries. Census uses the school district boundaries in producing population and poverty estimates at the school district level for NCES. These estimates are then used in the Title 1 allocation formula.

Over the past years, a letter has been mailed out by NCES to facilitate states cooperation in this project. For the first time ever, NCES sent this letter out via e-mail, which the CCD coordinator for your state may have been copied on.
