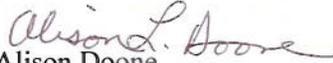

**SUBJECT:** Report on High-Dollar Overpayments for the Quarter Ended September 30, 2018

The purpose of this memorandum is to comply with the high-dollar overpayment reporting requirements addressed in Executive Order 13520, *Reducing Improper Payments*, dated November 20, 2009. Executive Order 13520 requires agency heads to submit quarterly reports on high-dollar overpayments for programs susceptible to significant improper payments.

The U.S. Department of Education, Federal Student Aid (FSA) has two programs identified as susceptible to significant improper payments: Pell Grants and Direct Loans. There were no high dollar overpayments during the reporting period covering July 1, 2018, through September 30, 2018.
