

RESOLUTION AGREEMENT
Kearsarge Regional School District / School Administrative Unit 65
OCR Complaint No. 01-17-1201

Prior to the completion of OCR's investigation and pursuant to Section 302 of OCR's *Case Processing Manual*, Kearsarge Regional School District / School Administrative Unit 65 (District) has voluntarily entered into this agreement to resolve Allegation 1 in the above-referenced complaint. The District assures that it will take the following actions:

Action Item

By November 1, 2019, the District will provide training to all administrators at the XXXXXXXX XXXXXX XXXX School, the District's Title IX Coordinator, and the District's Superintendent. The training will cover the need to determine at the outset if a complaint should be investigated under the District's Title IX procedures, and if so, the need to provide a prompt and equitable resolution, including appropriate notice to and equitable treatment of the parties, and the need for the District's Title IX Coordinator to coordinate the investigation of the complaint.

Reporting Requirements

Within 30 days of conducting the above-referenced training, the District will provide to OCR:

- i. A list of the individuals who attended the training and their positions;
- ii. The date(s) the training was conducted;
- iii. The name and credentials of the trainer(s)/presenter(s); and
- iv. Copies of any training materials disseminated.

The District understands that by signing this Agreement, it agrees to provide data and other information in a timely manner in accordance with the reporting requirements of the Agreement. Further, the District understands that during the monitoring of this Agreement, if necessary, OCR may visit the District, interview staff and students, and request such additional reports or data as are necessary for OCR to determine whether the District has fulfilled the terms and obligations of this Agreement. Upon the District's satisfaction of the commitments made under the Agreement, OCR will close the case.

The District understands and acknowledges that OCR may initiate proceedings to enforce the specific terms and obligations of this Agreement and/or the applicable statute(s) and regulation(s). Before initiating such proceedings, OCR shall give the Recipient written notice of the alleged breach and sixty (60) calendar days to cure the alleged breach.

The Agreement will become effective immediately upon the signature of the District's representative below.
