

RESOLUTION AGREEMENT
Weston Public Schools
OCR Complaint No. 01-20-1210

The Weston Public Schools (District) has voluntarily entered into this agreement (Agreement) to resolve the allegation in the above-referenced complaint. The District assures that it will take the following actions. The District agreed to resolve this complaint prior to the completion of OCR's investigation pursuant to Section 302 of OCR's *Case Processing Manual*.

Action Item 1

By October 9, 2020, the District will provide Section 504 and Title II training to Weston High School (School) special education administrators and the Director of XXXXX. The training will cover the District's obligation to: provide qualified students with disabilities a free appropriate public education designed to meet their individual educational needs as adequately as the needs of students without disabilities are met; and ensure that students with disabilities are afforded an equal opportunity to participate in non-academic and extracurricular services and activities.

Reporting Requirement:

By October 16, 2020, the District will provide to OCR:

- i. A list of the individuals who attended the training and their positions;
- ii. The date(s) the training was conducted; and
- iii. Copies of any training materials disseminated
- iv. The credentials of the trainer/presenter.

Action Item 2

By October 16, 2020, the District will invite the Complainant and Student to meet with the Student's Individualized Education Program team to discuss what accommodations may be available for the Student if he decides to enroll in XXXX XXXXXXXXXX II for the 2020-2021 school year, and any remaining questions the Complainant/Student have regarding the criteria for earning XXXXX XXXX and participating in the XXXXX XXXXX XXXXX Society.

Reporting Requirement:

By October 23, 2020, the District will provide to OCR:

- i. a copy of the written invitation sent to the Complainant and the Student;
- ii. a statement regarding whether the Complainant and the Student accepted the invitation; and, if so,
- iii. a summary of the discussion at the meeting and any determinations reached regarding Action Item 2.

The District understands that by signing this Agreement, it agrees to provide data and other information in a timely manner in accordance with the reporting requirements of the

Agreement. Further, the District understands that during the monitoring of this Agreement, if necessary, OCR may visit the District, interview staff and students, and request such additional reports or data as are necessary for OCR to determine whether the District has fulfilled the terms and obligations of this Agreement. Upon the District's satisfaction of the commitments made under the Agreement, OCR will close the case.

The District understands and acknowledges that OCR may initiate proceedings to enforce the specific terms and obligations of this Agreement and/or the applicable statute(s) and regulation(s). Before initiating such proceedings, OCR shall give the Recipient written notice of the alleged breach and sixty (60) calendar days to cure the alleged breach.

The Agreement will become effective immediately upon the signature of the District's representative below.
