

## **RESOLUTION AGREEMENT**

### **Case No. 02-19-1330 Cherry Hill Public Schools**

In order to resolve Case No. 02-19-1330, Cherry Hill Public Schools (the District) assures the U.S. Department of Education, Office for Civil Rights (OCR), that it will take the actions detailed below pursuant to the requirements of Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended, 29 U.S.C. § 794, and its implementing regulation at 34 C.F.R. Part 104, and Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (ADA), 42 U.S.C. § 12131 et seq., and its implementing regulation at 28 C.F.R. Part 35.

#### **Action Item: Accessibility of the Cherry Hill High School West Theater**

By April 1, 2020, the District will make changes as set forth in the attached Appendix to address accessibility issues with regard to the Cherry Hill High School West Theater's main entrance and wheelchair accessible areas.

**Reporting Requirement:** By April 1, 2020, the District will provide documentation to OCR (e.g., copies of paid invoices, photographs, etc.) confirming completion of each change referenced in the Appendix. OCR will then schedule an on-site visit to inspect the renovations.

The District understands that by signing this resolution agreement, it agrees to provide data and other information in a timely manner in accordance with the reporting requirements of the resolution agreement. Further, the District understands that during the monitoring of the resolution agreement, if necessary, OCR may visit the District, interview staff and students, and request such additional reports or data as are necessary for OCR to determine whether the District has fulfilled the terms and obligations of the resolution agreement. Upon the District's satisfaction of the commitments made under the resolution agreement, OCR will close this case.

The District understands and acknowledges that OCR may initiate proceedings to enforce the specific terms and obligations of the resolution agreement and/or the applicable statute(s) and regulation(s). Before initiating such proceedings, OCR will give the District written notice of the alleged breach and sixty (60) calendar days to cure the alleged breach.

This Agreement will become effective immediately upon the signature of the District's representative below.
