

**Resolution Agreement
Fulton County School District
OCR Docket Number 04-14-1498**

Fulton County School District (District) submits to the U.S. Department of Education, Office for Civil Rights (OCR), this Resolution Agreement (Agreement) to voluntarily resolve the issue in the above-referenced complaint and to ensure compliance with Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (Section 504) as amended, 29 U.S.C. § 794, and its implementing regulation at 34 C.F.R. Part 104, and Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (Title II), 42 U.S.C. §§ 12131 *et seq.*, and its implementing regulation, 28 C.F.R. Part 35. The Agreement reflects voluntary actions to be taken by the District to ensure continued compliance with Section 504 and Title II. The District agrees to implement the actions described below:

Student Focused Remedy

1. By **November 30, 2014**, the District will give the Student the opportunity to retake the following assessments: the Adios Papa Chapters 1-2 quiz taken on October 9, 2013, the Conjugating Verbs quiz taken on October 25, 2013, the Unit 2 exam taken on November 8, 2013, and the Preterite Versus Imperfect quiz taken on December 3, 2013. The District will obtain written verification from the Complainant by October 15, 2014 regarding which of the assessments the Student would like to retake. After the Student retakes the assessments, the District will recalculate the Student's final grade to include these grades and amend her final grade report to reflect her amended final grade in Spanish 2 Honors class.

Reporting Requirement: By **December 15, 2014**, the District will submit to OCR a statement showing the dates the Student retook the assessments listed in Paragraph 1 and her grades of each of those assessments. The District will also submit to OCR a copy of the Student's final grade report reflecting any changes in grades and the Student's amended final grade in Spanish 2 Honor class.

Section 504 and Title II – Training of District Staff

2. By **December 1, 2014**, the District will provide training for all teachers and staff at Riverwood International Charter School (School) on the implementation of Section 504 plans. This training should include the obligation of teachers and staff to review and make sure they understand the provisions of the 504 plans of all students they serve, and to fully implement all the provisions of the Section 504 plans.

Reporting Requirement: By **January 1, 2015**, the District will submit documentation to OCR showing that School staff has completed this training. The documentation shall include: (1) the date of the training session; (2) a list of names and titles of School employees who participated in the training sessions; (3) a description of the presenter's background and qualifications with respect to knowledge of Section 504 and Title II; and (4) a copy of the agenda and the training materials disseminated.

The District understands that by signing this Agreement, it agrees to provide data and other information in a timely manner in accordance with the reporting requirements of this agreement. The District understands that during the monitoring of this agreement, if necessary, OCR may visit the District, interview staff and students, and request additional reports or data as are necessary for OCR to determine whether the District has fulfilled the terms of this agreement and is in compliance with Section 504 and Title II implementing regulations set forth below which were at issue in this case. The District understands the OCR will not close the monitoring of this Agreement until OCR determines that the District has fulfilled the terms of this Agreement and is in compliance with the Section 504 implementing regulation at 34 C.F.R. §104.33 and the Title II implementing regulation at 28 C.F.R. § 35.130, which were at issue in this case.

This Resolution Agreement will become effective immediately upon the signature of the Superintendent or his/her designee below.
