

RESOLUTION AGREEMENT

LISA Academy Public Charter Schools OCR Case Number: 06141042

The LISA Academy Public Charter Schools (LISA) voluntarily submits this Resolution Agreement (Agreement) to the U.S. Department of Education, Office for Civil Rights (OCR), Dallas Office. By this Agreement, LISA commits to the following actions, consistent with the requirements of Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (Section 504), 29 U.S.C. § 794, and Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (Title II), 42 U.S.C. § 12132, and their respective implementing regulations. LISA understands that OCR will not close the monitoring of this Agreement until OCR determines that LISA has fulfilled the terms of this Agreement and is in compliance with the regulations implementing Section 504 and Title II, at 34 C.F.R. §§ 104.3, 104.4, 104.33-104.36, and 28 C.F.R. § 35.130, respectively, which were at issue in this case. LISA understands that by signing this Agreement, it agrees to provide data and other information in a timely manner in accordance with the reporting requirements of this Agreement. Further, LISA understands that during the monitoring of this Agreement, if necessary, OCR may visit LISA, interview staff and Students, and request such additional reports or data as are necessary for OCR to determine whether LISA has fulfilled the terms of this Agreement and is in compliance with the regulations implementing Section 504 and Title II. LISA understands and acknowledges that OCR may initiate administrative enforcement or judicial proceedings to enforce the specific terms and obligations of this Agreement. Before initiating administrative enforcement (34 C.F.R. §§ 100.9, 100.10), or judicial proceedings to enforce this Agreement, OCR shall give LISA written notice of the alleged breach and a minimum of sixty (60) calendar days to cure the alleged breach. This Agreement does not constitute an admission by LISA that it discriminated or otherwise engaged in any wrongdoing. LISA hereby voluntarily commits to the following:

ACTION ITEM

By the following dates, LISA will complete the following actions:

By **January 31, 2014**, LISA will provide training regarding its obligation under Section 504 and Title II to provide a FAPE to all qualified students with disabilities attending its schools. The training should be provided to all relevant personnel, including, but not limited to, LISA administrators, school administrators, faculty, and counselors. The training will be conducted by individuals knowledgeable about the laws and issues pertaining to disability discrimination. The training shall address, at a minimum:

- LISA's policies and procedures for carrying out its responsibilities under Section 504 and Title II to provide a FAPE to each qualified disabled person who is attending its schools, regardless of the nature or severity of the person's disability, including LISA staff members' obligation to evaluate any student who, because of disability, needs or is believed to need special education or related services.
