

Resolution Agreement
Gadsden Independent School District
OCR Case Number 08-20-1031

The U.S. Department of Education, Office for Civil Rights (OCR), initiated investigation of the above-referenced complaint against the Gadsden Independent School District (District) on October 10, 2020. OCR has jurisdiction under Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973, as amended, 29 U.S.C. § 794, 34 C.F.R. Part 104 and under Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990.

During the investigation the District indicated its willingness to take steps necessary to ensure compliance with Section 504 and Title II. Pursuant to Section 302 of OCR's *Case Processing Manual*, a complaint may be resolved when, before the conclusion of an investigation, a recipient expresses an interest in resolving the complaint, an agreement is appropriate, and the remedies align with the allegations. The agreement item below will resolve the allegation in this complaint. While entering into this Agreement, the District makes no admission of a violation of Federal law.

Agreement Item

By **June 30, 2020**, the District will provide the Student with 12 hours of compensatory education in the areas of the Student's greatest need as determined between the Student, Complainant and District.

Reporting Requirement

Within **14 days** of completion of the compensatory education for the Student, the District will send OCR written confirmation that the compensatory education has been completed.

The District understands that by signing this agreement, it agrees to provide data and other information in a timely manner in accordance with the reporting requirements of this Agreement. Further, OCR may interview individuals or request additional information to determine the District's compliance with the agreement.

The District understands and acknowledges that OCR may initiate administrative enforcement or judicial proceedings to enforce the specific terms and obligations of the Agreement. Before initiating administrative enforcement (34 C.F.R. §§ 100.9, 100.10), or judicial proceedings to enforce the Agreement, OCR shall give the District written notice of the alleged breach and a minimum of sixty (60) calendar days to cure the alleged breach.
