

**Resolution Agreement**  
**Camino Nuevo Charter Academy**  
**OCR Case No. 09-17-1685**

In order to respond to the compliance concerns provided to the U.S. Department of Education, Office for Civil Rights (OCR), in the investigation of the above-referenced complaint filed against the Camino Nuevo Charter Academy (Academy), pursuant to Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (Section 504), Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (Title II), and their implementing regulations, Academy, without admitting any violation of federal law, agrees to take the actions outlined in this Resolution Agreement (Agreement).

- A. Investigative Report; Investigation. The Academy will provide a written response to the harassment allegations asserted by the Complainant. The written response will memorialize the incidents of harassment alleged by the Complainant, describe the steps the Academy took to investigate these incidents, and explain the Academy's factual findings and conclusions as to each incident. The Academy will provide its investigative report and draft of its response to OCR for review and approval.

By January 30, 2018, the Academy will provide OCR for review and approval a copy of its final written response (which will include the appeal rights it will provide to the Complainant). Within 5 working days of OCR's approval of the written response, the Academy will issue the written response to the Complainant.

The Academy understands that by signing this Agreement, it agrees to provide data and other information in a timely manner. Further the Academy understands that during the monitoring of this Agreement, OCR may visit the Academy, interview staff and students and request such additional reports or data as are necessary for OCR to determine whether the Academy has fulfilled the terms of this Agreement and is in compliance with Section 504, Title II, and their implementing regulations, which were at issue in this case. Upon completion of the obligations under this Agreement, OCR shall close and dismiss this case.

The Academy understands and acknowledges that OCR may initiate administrative enforcement or judicial proceedings to enforce the specific terms and obligations of this Agreement. Before initiating administrative enforcement (34 C.F.R. §§ 100.9, 100.10), or judicial proceedings to enforce this Agreement, OCR shall give the Academy written notice of the alleged breach and sixty (60) calendar days to cure the alleged breach.
