

RESOLUTION AGREEMENT
Florence Public School District One
OCR Complaint No. 11-15-1104

Florence Public School District One (the District) agrees to fully implement this Resolution Agreement (the Agreement) to resolve Office for Civil Rights (OCR) Complaint No. 11-15-1104 filed by the Complainant on behalf of his son (the Student). This Agreement does not constitute an admission by the District of a violation of Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (Section 504), Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (Title II), or any other law enforced by OCR.

COMMITMENTS

1. By April 30, 2015 the District will <XXXX PARAGRAPH REDACTED XXXX>

Reporting Requirement

Within two weeks of purchasing the XXXX to the XXXX the District will submit to OCR a copy of a receipt confirming the purchase of three XXXX for the Student, his sister and the Complainant. The District will also provide OCR with a copy of a certified mail receipt reflecting that the XXXX were mailed to the Complainant.

2. By April 30, 2015 the District will submit to OCR a draft memorandum to administrators and teachers at the school of the Complainant's daughter that provides guidance regarding the Complainant's right to access the school and any limitations on access, including compliance with directives of District staff while present on campus.

Reporting Requirement

Within 15 days of OCR's approval, the District will provide OCR documentation (including a distribution list and copy of final memorandum) that the guidance memorandum has been provided to all teachers and administrators at the Complainant's daughter's school. Within the same timeframe, the District will provide documentation that the final memorandum has been provided to the Complainant.

The District understands that OCR will not close monitoring of this Agreement until OCR determines that the District has fulfilled the terms of this Agreement and is in compliance with the regulations implementing Section 504 and Title II, which were at issue in the complaint.

The District understands that, by signing this Agreement, it agrees to provide information in a timely manner in accordance with the reporting requirements of this Agreement. Further, the District understands that during the monitoring of this agreement, if necessary, OCR may visit the District, interview staff and groups of students, and request such additional reports or data as are necessary for OCR to determine that the District has fulfilled the terms of this Agreement and

is in compliance with the regulations implementing Section 504 and Title II, which were at issue in the complaint.

The District understands and acknowledges that OCR may initiate administrative enforcement or judicial proceedings to enforce the specific terms and obligations of the Agreement. Before initiating administrative enforcement (34 C.F.R. §§ 100.9, 100.10), or judicial proceedings to enforce this agreement, OCR shall give the District written notice of the alleged breach and a minimum of sixty (60) calendar days to cure the alleged breach.
