Ravenna Public Schools Resolution Agreement OCR Docket #15-22-1222

Ravenna Public Schools (the District) voluntarily submits this Resolution Agreement (Agreement) to the U.S. Department of Education, Office for Civil Rights (OCR), for the purpose of resolving the above-referenced complaint and ensuring compliance with Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972 (Title IX), 20 U.S.C. § 1681 *et seq.*, and its implementing regulation at 34 C.F.R. Part 106, Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (Section 504), 29 U.S.C. § 794, and its implementing regulation at 34 C.F.R. Part 104, and Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (Title II), 42 U.S.C. § 12131 *et seq.*, and its implementing regulation at 28 C.F.R. Part 35.

The District agrees to take the following actions:

- 1. By May 2, 2022, the District will publish the contact information (i.e., telephone number, office address, and e-mail address) for its Title IX coordinator(s) and Section 504 coordinator(s). At a minimum, the contact information will be available on the District's website and in building handbooks.
 - **Reporting Requirement:** By May 2, 2022, the District will provide OCR with documentation showing that the District implemented Item 1.
- 2. By May 2, 2022, the District will ensure that any grievance procedures referenced in building handbooks are consistent with the District's Board Policies.

Reporting Requirement: By May 2, 2022, the District will provide OCR with documentation showing that the District implemented Item 2.

General Requirements

The District understands that, by signing this Agreement, it agrees to provide data and other information in a timely manner in accordance with the reporting requirements of the Agreement. Further, the District understands that during the monitoring of this Agreement, if necessary, OCR may visit the District, interview staff and students, and request such additional reports or data as are necessary for OCR to determine whether the District has fulfilled the terms and obligations of the Agreement. Upon the District's satisfaction of the terms and obligations of the Agreement, OCR will close the case.

The District understands and acknowledges that OCR may initiate proceedings to enforce the specific terms and obligations of the Agreement and/or applicable statute(s) and regulation(s). Before initiating such proceedings, OCR will give the District written notice of the alleged breach and 60 calendar days to cure the alleged breach.

The Agreement will become effective immediately upon the signature of the District's representative below.
