University of Michigan Resolution Agreement OCR Docket #15-22-2010

The University of Michigan (the University) voluntarily submits this Resolution Agreement (Agreement) to the U.S. Department of Education, Office for Civil Rights (OCR), for the purpose of resolving the above-referenced complaint and ensuring compliance with Section 504 of the Rehabilitation Act of 1973 (Section 504), 29 U.S.C. § 794, and its implementing regulation at 34 C.F.R. Part 104, and Title II of the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (Title II), 42 U.S.C. § 12131 *et seq.*, and its implementing regulation at 28 C.F.R. Part 35.

The University agrees to take the following actions:

1. By November 4, 2022, the University will provide OCR, for OCR's review and approval, a plan to relocate the Michigan Community Scholars Program – which is currently located in both Allen House and Chicago House of the West Quadrangle dormitory – to a location within Michigan Housing that is fully accessible by individuals with mobility impairments prior to the beginning of the 2023-2024 school year. The plan must ensure that the housing provides comparable, convenient, and accessible housing to students with mobility impairments at the same cost as to students without disabilities, and that the housing is available in sufficient quantity and variety so that the scope of choice of living accommodations for students with mobility impairments is, as a whole, comparable to that of students without disabilities. The plan will also include an interim plan, to address the situation where a student with a mobility impairment joins the Michigan Community Scholars Program during the 2022-2023 school year.

Reporting Requirement: By November 4, 2022, the University will provide OCR with its plan, pursuant to Item 1.

2. By August 1, 2023, the University will provide OCR with a list of students participating in the Michigan Community Scholars Program for the 2023-2024 school year. The list will include the student's first and last name and their housing assignment, and will note if the student has a mobility impairment. This list will not be used to directly contact the students.

Reporting Requirement: By August 1, 2023, the University will provide OCR with the list of students, pursuant to Item 2.

General Requirements

The University understands and acknowledges that OCR may initiate proceedings to enforce the specific terms and obligations of the Agreement and/or Section 504 and Title II and their implementing regulations, 34 C.F.R. Part 104 and 28 C.F.R. Part 35. Before initiating such proceedings, OCR will give the University written notice of the alleged breach and 60 calendar days to cure the alleged breach.

Page 2 – University of Michigan #15-22-2010 – Resolution Agreement

The University understands that OCR will not close the monitoring of this Agreement until OCR determines that the University has demonstrated compliance with all the terms of this Agreement and is in compliance with Section 504 and Title II and their implementing regulations, which were at issue in this complaint.
