Thank you for your letter of July 22, 1985, regarding Concordia Lutheran College's request for religious exemption from Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972. In your letter, you indicated that you wish to withdraw your request for a religious exemption if this would not prejudice a future exemption request. An institution may request a religious exemption from the Title IX regulation at any time. Your decision to withdraw your request does not prejudice a determination by the Office for Civil Rights (OCR) regarding any future religious exemption request you may submit. Accordingly, OCR has closed your request file.
