Dear Reverend Kirlin:

The Office for Civil Rights (OCR) of the Department of Education notified you by letter dated May 17, 1985 (copy enclosed), that we had reviewed your request for religious exemption to Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972 and determined that St. John Vianney College need not have applied for religious exemption. OCR requested that you respond within 60 days if you sought exemption to sections of the Title IX regulation other than the admissions and recruitment provisions.

OCR is assuming that a religious exemption for St. John Vianney College is unnecessary since you did not contact us within 60 days. Therefore, OCR has closed your request file.
