Dear Mr. Feigelstock:

On March 29, 1985, the Office for Civil Rights (OCR) of the Department of Education sent to Yeshivah Chofetz Chaim of Radun a request for sufficient information which would enable OCR to process your institution's request for religious exemption from Title IX of the Education Amendments of 1972. OCR received no response to this request and sent a second request for information on July 11, 1985. Additionally, OCR sent a clarification of its information request to Yeshivah Chofetz Chaim of Radun on August 7, 1985.

OCR did not receive a response from your institution to our three requests and sent a final request for information on September 20, 1985. This final request indicated that if we did not hear from you by October 15, OCR would assume that your institution is no longer interested in receiving a religious exemption and close your request file.

OCR has not received a response from your institution to our four requests for information. Accordingly, the Office for Civil Rights has closed the request file for Yeshivah Chofetz Chaim of Radun.
