SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority

I. **DELEGATION**

Under the authority vested in me by Section 412 of the Department of Education Organization Act, 20 U.S.C. § 3472, and Personnel Manual Instruction 451-1, dated May 26, 2006, Sections V. C. and D., and your authority pursuant to Section 6(d) of the Inspector General Act, as amended, I hereby delegate to you, to your successor in function, or to anyone serving for you in an acting capacity, the authority to approve special act awards and time-off awards for Senior Executive Service (SES) employees of the Office of Inspector General (OIG). This includes the authority to approve special act awards up to \$10,000 for SES employees of OIG.

II. **CONDITIONS**

OIG shall follow the principles I have established for approving special act and time-off awards including that special act awards are not to be based upon an employee's performance rating of record or a particular appraisal cycle, but rather are to be based upon a special act or service in the public interest in connection with or related to official employment. Additionally, time-off awards are to be used to provide immediate recognition to an employee who performs particular tasks, assignments, or other job responsibilities in an exemplary manner or makes a suggestion which directly contributes to economy in, or the effectiveness of, government operations.

III. **RESERVATIONS**

None.

IV. **REDELEGATION**

This authority may not be redelegated.

V. CERTIFICATION AND EFFECTIVE DATE

This delegation is effective upon certification by the Department's Principal Delegations Control Officer. It supersedes all previous delegations of this specific authority.
