SUBJECT: Delegation of Authority

I. <u>DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY</u>

Under the authority vested in me by section 412 of the Department of Education Organization Act, 20 U.S.C. §3472, and in accordance with section 3544 (a) (3) of the Federal Information Security Act of 2002 (FISMA), I hereby delegate to you, your successor in function, and anyone serving for you in an acting capacity, the authority to perform management functions to ensure compliance with the requirements of the FISMA, including the authority to designate a senior agency information security officer.

Unless otherwise noted in future delegations of authority, amendments to the authority cited herein are included within the scope of this delegation.

II. <u>RESERVATIONS</u>: None.

III. <u>REDELEGATION</u>

Subject to the requirements of law, you may redelegate the authority delegated to you. No further redelegation is authorized.
