#### I. DELEGATION

Under the authority vested in me by a delegation from the Secretary, delegation EA/EM/340 certified on March 4, 2008, I hereby delegate to you, and to anyone serving for you in an acting capacity, the authority to administer the Department's responsibilities under section 550 of the Federal Property and Administrative Services Act of 1949, as amended (40 U.S.C. 550 et seq.).

Unless otherwise noted in future delegations of authority, amendments to the authority delegated herein are included within the scope of this delegation.

#### II. RESERVATIONS

Unless otherwise noted in existing or future delegations of authority, the following are not delegated:

- A. the authority to sign <u>Federal Register</u> notices;
- B. the authority to award discretionary grants and contracts for goods and services;
- C. the authority to appoint, and fix compensation of, members of advisory councils; and
- D. unless otherwise provided by law, the authority to submit reports to the Congress or the President.
