SUBJECT: Redlegation of Authority to Approve Interagency Agreements with other Federal Agencies, International Organizations, and Foreign Governments, Including Memoranda of Understanding or Statements of Work in Support of Such Interagency Agreements, Within Your Area of Responsibility Pursuant to Administrative Communications System Departmental Directive OPEPD: 1-101 and to Enter into Agreements Within Your Area of Responsibility with Entities Outside of the U.S. Department of Education

I. DELEGATION

Pursuant to the Secretary's delegation of authority to me under Section IV.A. of Administrative Communications System (ACS) Departmental Directive OPEPD: 1-101, dated July 16, 2010 (as recertified on June 1, 2017) for approval of interagency agreements with other Federal agencies, international organizations, and foreign governments as the Principal Officer of the U.S. Department of Education (ED) to whom responsibility for the administration of the affected Federal student financial assistance programs under title IV of the Higher Education Act of 1965 (HEA), as amended (excluding the development of policy) has been statutorily assigned (20 U.S.C. 1018), I hereby redelegate to you, your successor in function, or anyone acting for you in your position as Deputy Chief Operating Officer for Student Experience and Aid Delivery, the authority to approve interagency agreements with other Federal agencies, international organizations, and foreign governments, including memoranda of understanding or statements of work in support of such interagency agreements that describe the activities covered thereunder (but excluding Computer Matching Agreements), within your area of responsibility, as described in ACS Departmental Directive OPEPD: 1-101.

In addition, pursuant to the Secretary's delegation of authority to me in Delegation of Authority EA/EN/96, certified on May 4, 2021, I hereby also redelegate authority to you, your successor in function, or anyone acting for you in your position as Deputy Chief Operating Officer for Student Experience and Aid Delivery the authority to enter into agreements (excluding Computer Matching Agreements) within your area of responsibility with entities outside of ED, including State agencies, lenders, guaranty agencies, and educational institutions.

II. DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

SEAD is responsible for ensuring that students, parents, and borrowers know about the availability of Federal financial aid and how to access this aid. SEAD is also charged with providing borrowers with information, tools, and resources on loan repayment to help them manage their debt. SEAD shares information and engages with customers via multiple communication channels. SEAD interagency agreements and other agreements with entities outside of ED primarily focus on two areas: 1) processing the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA®) and 2) loan servicing and debt collection.

III. RESERVATIONS

This redelegation does not extend to Computer Matching Agreements administered under ACS Departmental Directive OCIO: 4-101 or to Intergovernmental Personnel Act agreements.

Unless otherwise noted in existing or future delegations of authority, the following are not delegated:

- A. the authority to sign Federal Register notices;
- B. the authority to award contracts and discretionary grants;
- C. the authority to appoint, and fix compensation of, members of advisory councils; and
- D. unless otherwise provided by law, the authority to submit reports to Congress or the President.

IV. REDELEGATION

This authority may not be redelegated.

V. CERTIFICATION AND EFFECTIVE DATE

This redelegation is effective upon certification by the Department's Principal Delegations Control Officer. I hereby ratify actions within the scope of this delegation taken by you prior to certification of this delegation. This redelegation supersedes Delegation EN1/ENC/93 certified on January 12, 2021.
