**SUBJECT:** Redlegation of Programmatic Authority

I. DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY

Under the authority vested in me by a delegation from the Secretary, EA/ES/87, certified on February 3, 2012, I hereby redelegate to you, your successor in function, and anyone serving for you in an acting capacity, the programmatic authority under Title VIII of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act of 1965 (the Act), as amended, 20 U.S.C. 7701 et seq.

This includes the authority to:

- A. Make grants and payments, as well as any determinations, including repayment agreements, related to a local educational agency's application for assistance under sections 8002, 8003, and 8007 of the Act;
- B. Enter into agreements, with review by the Office of the General Counsel, as appropriate, in the form of deeds, contracts, permits, and other documents necessary for the administration of the Impact Aid program (IAP) with parties outside the Department of Education; and
- C. Make determinations or certifications as required under section 8009 of the Act, with review by the Office of the General Counsel, as appropriate.

Unless otherwise noted in future delegations of authority, amendments to the authorities delegated herein are included in the scope of this delegation.

II. RESERVATIONS

Unless otherwise noted in existing or future delegations of authority, the following are not delegated:

- A. The authority to sign documents for publication in the Federal Register;
- B. The authority to appoint members of advisory councils and fix compensation;
- C. The authority to issue Program Determination Letters or other audit determination documents specifically authorized under Part E of the General Education Provisions Act (20 USC 1234-1234e); and
- D. Unless otherwise provided by law, the authority to submit reports to Congress or the President.

III. REDELEGATION

No further redefinition is authorized.

IV. CERTIFICATION AND EFFECTIVE DATE

This delegation is effective upon certification by the Departmental Delegations Control Officer. It supersedes delegation ES/ESA/74. I hereby ratify actions within the scope of this delegation taken by the addressee prior to the date of certification.
