- A. the authority to sign documents for publication in the <u>Federal Register</u> other than those documents designated in the blanket delegation of authority to sign <u>Federal Register</u> documents issued to Principal Officers, EA/GEN/12, certified on June 15, 2006;
- B. the authority to appoint members of advisory councils and fix compensation; and
- C. unless otherwise provided by law, the authority to submit reports to Congress or the President.

III. REDELEGATION

Subject to applicable provisions of law, and unless otherwise noted, you may redelegate any of the authorities delegated to you, and may authorize further redelegation. All redelegations must be prepared in accordance with the Administrative Communications System directive, OM: 1-102: Delegations of Authority, dated July 29, 2008.

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IV. CERTIFICATION AND EFFECTIVE DATE

This delegation is effective upon certification by the Department's Principal Delegations Control Officer.
