### **PROGRAM DESCRIPTION**

Between 1950 and 1993, the College Housing Loans, Higher Education Facilities Loans, and College Housing and Academic Facilities Loans programs (CHAFL) helped to ensure that postsecondary institutions were able to make the capital improvements they needed to maintain and increase their ability to provide a high-quality education. P. L. 104-19 repealed the programs' authority to subsidize gross loan obligations after 1994; since that time, the Administration's role has been to manage the outstanding loans.

### FY 2020 BUDGET REQUEST

For fiscal year 2020, the Administration requests \$435,000 for Federal administration of the facilities loans program. Funding levels for the past 5 fiscal years were:
