



Dear Dr. Harris:

At its April 2017 meeting, the Council considered your institution's application for an initial grant of accreditation, the visit report, and the responses to the report. The visit yielded 16 findings, of which the institution has satisfied 10. As a result of its review, the Council requires additional information for the following based on the *Accreditation Criteria*:

1. The admissions policy is not administered as written, and foreign transcripts of international students seeking admission have not been evaluated for equivalency (Sections 3-1-411(a) and 3-6-602). Not all of the foreign transcripts for students at the bachelor's degree or graduate degree level have been evaluated by an agency approved by ACICS for equivalency. Per the institution's admissions policy in their catalog, secondary or high school transcripts and any college transcripts are required for admission to the undergraduate program, or college transcripts of a bachelor's degree for the graduate programs. The institution submitted student affidavits attesting to high school graduation for the undergraduate program; however, this is not in accordance with their current published admissions policy requiring the actual transcripts. Further, at the graduate level, the institution referenced their plan to require evaluations for equivalency from approved agencies in the future; however, evidence must be provided to demonstrate that the standards are currently being met.
2. The institution has no documentation to support the systematic monitoring of its recruitment activities (Section 3-1-412(a)). The institution responded that they do not actively recruit new students but rely on referrals, without providing any evidence of policy or systematic monitoring of referral sources. Further, equivalent but limited recruitment activity (to include college nights, speaking engagements, or the handling of phone inquiries) is done by the admissions director, registrar, academic dean, or the president. Due to the small size of the institution, the response indicated that no system of monitoring was necessary. Therefore, the institution did not provide evidence of the

necessary systematic monitoring of recruitment activities that ACICS requires for all institutions.

3. The SAP policy does not include all required elements (Section 3-1-420 and Appendix D). The SAP policy previously did not address the effects of the following on successful course completion percentage requirement: withdrawal, incomplete grades or non-punitive grades, repeated courses, when a student changes programs or seeks to earn additional credentials, or transfer credits. The institution provided a chart with SAP policy definitions addressing each of the missing elements; however, the Council found contradictory terms on the Glossary, and there was no evidence that any revised policy and procedure has been added to the catalog, distributed to students, or implemented.
4. There was no evidence of written learning contracts between students and faculty for independent study (Section 3-1-513(a) and Glossary). At the time of the visit, the institution was running several independent study courses (32 online and 17 residential) without appropriate learning contracts. In response to the finding, the institution submitted a narrative on their intent to decrease the number of independent studies as their student population grows, as well as a new independent study contract form. However, there was no evidence that the contract has been implemented.
5. There was no documentation to support that faculty or students have been trained in the use of library resources (Section 3-1-800(f)). The institution provided updated faculty and student orientation manuals that include sections on the use of library resources. Further, trained staff has been designated to train students and faculty during their orientation or individually on e-library use, and the signed and dated training document will be kept in the student or faculty file. However, there was no evidence documenting that any library training has occurred.
6. Undergraduate programs do not have the minimum required credit hours in the area of concentration (Section 3-5-202). In response to the finding, the institution submitted meeting minutes outlining changes to courses/programs to meet hour requirements, but no updated Academic Credit Analysis was provided for any of the courses that were altered.

Council Action

Therefore, the Council acted to defer further action on the application until its next meeting, July 31-August 4, 2017, pending receipt of the following information:

1. Evidence that all foreign transcripts of all current international students in the graduate programs have been evaluated by a member of either the Association of International Credential Evaluators (AICE), American Association of Collegiate Registrars and Admissions Officers (AACRAO), or National Association of Credential Evaluation

Services (NACES) to validate equivalency with graduation from high school and eligibility to enter college or university in the United States. Documentation must include, but is not limited to, a list of all current graduate students along with copies of their transcripts and the completed evaluation.

Further, for the undergraduate program, if the institution accepts attestations of high school graduation for admission to the undergraduate programs, then a revised admissions policy must be submitted in a draft catalog stating such. Alternatively, the institution must submit evidence that transcripts are on file for all currently enrolled students in the undergraduate program and the evaluation for equivalency for all foreign transcripts. Documentation must include, but is not limited to, a list of all current undergraduate students along with copies of their transcripts and any completed evaluations.

2. Evidence that any person or entity engaged in admissions or recruitment activities on its behalf is communicating current and accurate information regarding courses and programs, student achievement disclosures (see Section 3-1-704), services, tuition, terms, and operating policies. The institution must provide documentation to demonstrate the systematic monitoring of its recruitment activities, both through external referral sources and internal personnel outreach.
3. An updated draft catalog that includes the revised SAP policy that explains how withdrawals, incomplete grades or non-punitive grades, repeated courses, when a student changes programs or seeks to earn additional credentials, or transfer credits affect both the cumulative grade point average and successful course completion percentage calculations of its revised SAP. Further, the institution must provide evidence of systematic and effective implementation in practice, with an explanatory narrative and support documentation.
4. A policy outlining how the institution will guarantee that regularly scheduled classes are offered to students when needed in the normal pursuit of their programs of study, as well as a plan to implement this policy and reduce the number of independent studies. In addition, the institution must include a list of all students enrolled at the institution, indicating those currently taking an independent study course; a copy of the signed learning contract for each student that is currently taking an independent study course; a schedule of all courses in the current term, indicating which are independent studies; and a justification for each independent study course that was taken by each student on the list.
5. Evidence that training in the use of library resources has occurred for faculty and students. Documentation must include, but is not limited to, a training schedule, training manuals, and signed documentation that each individual has received proper training to assist students with library functions.

6. Evidence that the undergraduate programs now contain the necessary clock hours of coursework in the area of concentration. Documentation must include, but is not limited to, a draft catalog with the new courses and academic credit analyses (ACA) for the recently added concentration electives to meet the 60 semester credit hours requirement in the area of concentration. Further, the institution must provide a compelling narrative explanation for this failure to ensure its compliance with a fundamental requirement for its academic programs to offer sufficient credit hours in the area of concentration and its impact on currently enrolled students.

The information listed above must be received in the Council office electronically by **June 30, 2017**. Failure to provide all information responsive to the Council's review and action represented in this notification may result in the denial of your institution's application for initial accreditation.

At its August 2017 meeting, the Council considered the institution's application for an initial grant of accreditation with its most recent response to the findings in the Council's letter dated May 5, 2017.

The institution first appeared before the Council in April 2017 with 16 findings and, having provided information that satisfactorily addressed 10, was deferred to the August 2017 meeting. As a result of its most recent review, while the institution was able to resolve five findings, the Council found the following based on the *Accreditation Criteria*:

- The Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) policy does not include all required elements (Section 3-1-420 and Appendix D). In response to the finding, the institution submitted an updated catalog with a revised SAP policy, which now explains how withdrawals, incomplete or non-punitive grades, repeated courses, program transfer, earning an additional credential from the institution, and transfer credits affect both the cumulative grade point average and successful course completion percentage calculations of its revised SAP. However, no documentation was submitted to evidence the revised SAP policy in practice.

Council Action

Therefore, the Council acted to **defer further action** on the application until its December 2017 meeting pending receipt of the following information:

- Evidence of systematic and effective implementation of the institution's revised SAP policy *in practice*. The institution must submit an explanatory narrative and supporting documentation to include a degree audit of all students enrolled from April 1, 2017, to October 1, 2017. The report must identify all students who have withdrawn from a course, received an incomplete or non-punitive grade in a course, repeated a course,

changed programs, earned an additional credential from the institution, and transferred in credits to the institution. In conjunction with the report, academic transcripts must be submitted for those students identified. Evidence of notification to students of their placement on probation, for not meeting SAP due to any of the above items, must be included in the form of certified mail receipts or in-person meetings signed by both the student and the administrator.

The information or reports listed above must be received in the Council office electronically by **October 31, 2017**. Failure to provide all information requested by the Council may result in the denial of your institution's application.
