The State reported that it conducts a separate monitoring activity periodically to ensure indicators are being met continually. In FFY 2006, this activity identified 20 children as not having a transition conference within the appropriate timeframe. Of those 20 children, two were due to family circumstances and 18 were due to a lack of appropriate planning on the part of one service coordinator. Transition conferences did occur for all 18 children prior to their third birthday, but not within the appropriate timeframe. The State provided training and technical assistance to the service coordinator on appropriate planning and scheduling of transition conferences.
